PUBLIC FORUM

A member of the public observed there has been an increase in the numbers of bikes, e-bikes and motorbikes in the area. Cllr Watson suggested that 101 be called if the member felt unsafe or if an incident should be reported.

A member of the public asked if an extra bin could be put outside the shop. The rubbish bins in the village are often full before emptying day. Clerk will contact highways to see if bins can be increased in number or volume.

A member of the public noticed there is an increase in speeding vehicles and asked if 'gates' could be put at the entrances to the village. It has been noted these can help to slow drivers down. Clerk will contact highways to see if it would be possible – the land the 'gates' would go on does not belong to GHPC.

A member of the public noted the road by the school has blistered in the heat. Clerk to contact highways.

A member of the public asked whey the Police Support Officer is not seen in the village, a presence may help to deter fly posting, fly tipping and speeding. Clerk to request.
